



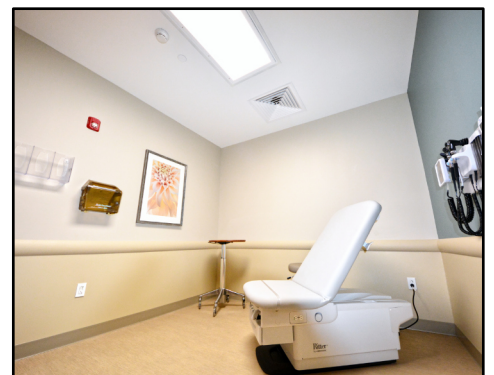

## UPMC Celebrates New Twin Lakes Addition

A ribbon cutting ceremony was held for UPMC's newest addition to their Twin Lakes facility located in Somerset, PA. The facility, which specializes in substance use disorder withdrawal management and residential addiction treatment, received a 18,400 sq. ft. treatment center and includes a 60% increase in beds (64 beds in total). The project also created 26 new jobs to the region.

Our team worked alongside the architects at CPL to enhance the new addition with highly advanced and efficient HVAC and lighting systems which included a packaged rooftop system with VAV terminals, LED lighting, and controls throughout the space.



## Historic Bedford County Courthouse Receives Enhanced Security Entrance

The 195 year old Bedford County Courthouse's \$1.1 Million initiative to upgrade their security entrance was finalized over the summer. As the oldest active courthouse in the state, it was with utmost importance to balance the necessary security improvements while also preserving the important historical nature of the courthouse. The project included a modernized single-point entrance and exit with state-of-the-art security camera systems, installation of duress alarms and public emergency announcement systems, and secured office areas. This project exemplifies how we can combine sophisticated technology with nearly 200 year-old facilities.
